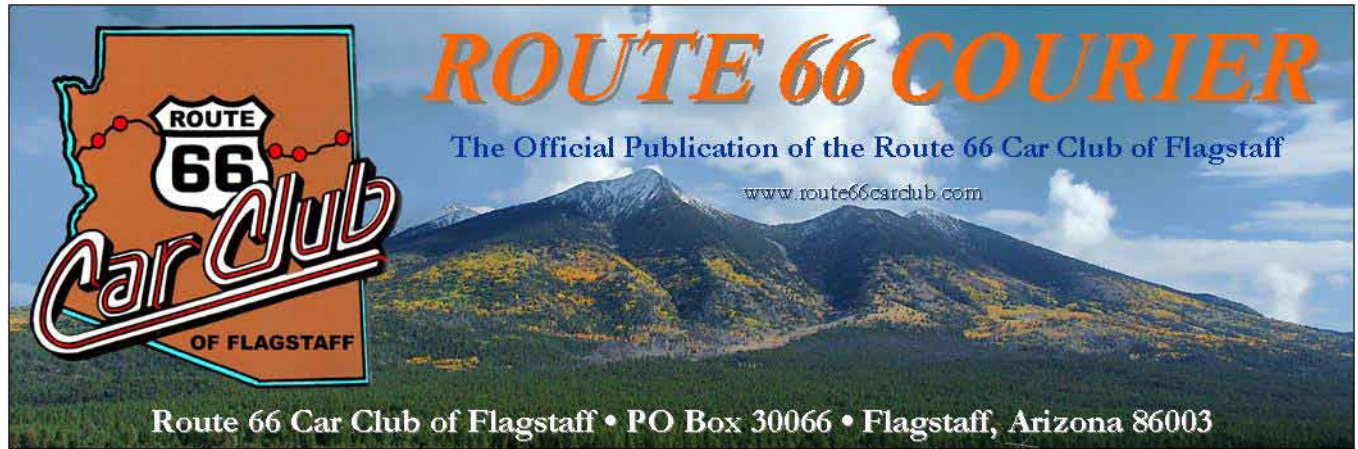

Route 66 Car Show Charity Distribution

At the November General Membership Meeting, the membership voted on the distribution. Kathy Strango, the Treasurer, reported that \$17,500 was available for distribution. The membership voted to make 6 awards of \$2,916.67 each in addition to the \$500 already awarded to the NAU ROTC program and the Humane Society 50/50 net of \$883.
